Sustainable Communities

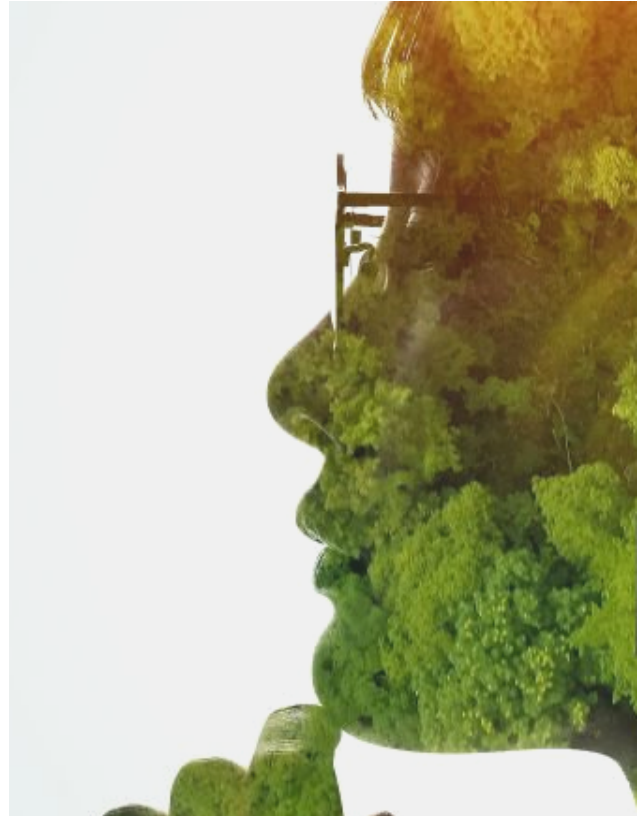
How can digital technologies be used to promote sustainable behaviour in local communities?

Challenge
